### I RoHS – II Reach – III Conflict minerals

#### I EU-Directive 2011/65/EU [ROHS II]

Dear DST Customers,

By referring to customer inquiries, we hereby confirm that the products we distribute and supply meet the requirements of Directive 2011/65 / EU of the European Parliament and of the Council of 8 June 2011 on the restriction of the use of hazardous substances in electrical and electronic equipment [recast ] fulfill.

For the production and also for the function of our products, lead, cadmium, chromium VI, or mercury-containing materials as well as PBB or PBDE are not necessary and are therefore neither used nor added. The occurrence of the above mentioned substances is therefore not to be expected. We do not carry out our own analyzes of these substances and refer to corresponding statements from our manufacturing partners. Since any presence of traces of impurities by the substances listed in the ppm range cannot be completely excluded, we would like to point out that further Processing users are not released from corresponding individual tests.

In addition, according to the current state, there are no substances of very high concern (SVHC) under Regulation (EC) 1907/2006 (Reach), as of 2015 Over 0.1% (w / w). According to our research and due to the information provided by our suppliers, the products obtained by DST GmbH contain Neither SVHC nor arise during processing.

As a result of this measure, we completely cover the area of the Reach regulation, which is applicable by DST GmbH, and thus actively implement the EU chemicals policy.


##### Conflict minerals:

The products delivered by us to our customers, do not contain conflict minerals according to the Dodd-Frank Act, Section 1502. No tantalum, tantalum or tungsten are used in these products. After consultation with our suppliers, there are also no direct or indirect business contacts to the listed sources of the CRD countries.

*(Sec. 1502) Expresses the sense of Congress that the exploitation and trade of conflict minerals originating in the Democratic Republic of the Congo (DRC) helps finance conflict characterized by extreme levels of violence in the eastern DRC , particularly sexual- and gender-based violence, and contributes to an emergency humanitarian situation therein, warranting certain disclosures under the Securities Exchange Act of 1934.*
